Positive	Negative	Question	
• I am.	• I am not.	• Am !?	
• You are.	You are not.	<ul><li>Are you?</li></ul>	
• We are.	<ul> <li>We are not.</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Are we?</li></ul>	
• They are.	<ul> <li>They are not.</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Are they?</li></ul>	
• He is.	He is not.	• Is he?	
• She is.	<ul> <li>She is not.</li> </ul>	• <b>Is</b> she?	
• It is.	• It is not.	• Is it?

## SIMPLE PAST – ADVERBS OF TIME

- AGO
- ✓ I was at the cafeteria 10 minutes <u>ago</u>.
- YESTERDAY
- ✓ We were at Brian's house <u>yesterday</u>.
- THE DAY BEFORE YESTERDAY
- ✓ Was she playing LOL the day before yesterday?
- LAST (WEEK MONTH YEAR)
- ✓ Jack and Lindsay weren't in Italy *last month*.

TO WALK			
Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative	
l walked	l didn't walk	Did I walk?	
You walked	You didn't walk	Did you walk?	_
He walked	He didn't walk	Did he walk?	
We walked	We didn't walk	Did we walk?	
They walked	They didn't walk	Did they walk?	

### SIMPLE PAST - ED

- ·Add 'ed' to the verb:
- Start → started
- •Finish → finished
- ·Verbs ending with 'e', add just 'd'
- Arrive → arrived
- Survive → Survived

- AFFIRMATIVE
- □I <u>saw</u> your sister on the street yesterday.
- NEGATIVE
- □I didn't <u>see</u> your sister on the street yesterday.
- INTERROGATIVE
- □ <u>Did</u> you <u>see</u> my sister on the street yesterday?
